Care Worker Practice Course

(Two-year college course)

- Those who enroll in this course will not have to pay the entrance fee (¥150,000)
- 8:50am to 2:20pm Attending lectures at University
 After attending lectures Working at nursing homes
- The income students earn at nursing homes will be used for the tuition fees
- After successful completion of this two-year course and passing the national examination, students can get a national certification of care worker in Japan
